The St Barth Gourmet Festival is returning this year for its eight edition.

The week-long gastronomic event will take place from Nov. 10-14, 2021, Caribbean Journal has learned.

It's part of the broader "Gourmet Month" on the island, alongside Caribbean Rum Awards, which take place Nov. 2-7 with a week of high-level rum (and cigar) events.

This year's Gourmet Festival will include a lineup of award-winning chefs featuring some of France's top culinary talent.
