



SAINT-BARTHELEMY COVID-19 TRAVEL REGULATIONS

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL TRAVELERS TO SAINT – BARTHELEMY:

TRAVELERS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY TO SAINT-BARTHELEMY WITH THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- A. THE INBOUND TRAVELERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A NEGATIVE PCR COVID-19 RESULT OF TEST DONE WITHIN 72 HRS OF TRAVEL AT AN ACCREDITED LABORATORY HOST COUNTRY. THESE RESULTS WILL BE CHECKED AT AIRPORT FOR VALIDITY.
- B. THE INBOUND TRAVELERS TO/FR GUADELOUPE ARE PROHIBITED, UNLESS THEY ARE BASED ON A COMPELLING REASONS THAT CAN NOT BE POSTPONED. TRAVELERS IN THIS CATEGORY WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW A NEGATIVE PCR TEST WITHIN 72 HRS.
- C. WEAR A FACE MASK COVERING BOTH NOSE AND MOUTH WHILE AT THE AIRPORT.
- D. INBOUND TRAVELERS ARE ASKED FOR COMMITMENT TO RESPECT PROPHYLACTIC ISOLATION MEASURES (LIMIT CONTACT AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE AND NOT FREQUENTING PUBLIC AREAS FOR THE FIRST 7 DAYS ON THE ISLAND, IN PARTICULAR RESTAURANTS, BARS, SHOPS, CHURCHS). HE OR SHE WILL BE ASKED TO BE TESTED ON DAY 7 (IF STILL ON THE ISLAND) WITH A PCR COVID-19 TEST.
