Anyone arriving to St. Barts will be asked to follow this ethical engagement to self-isolate from persons outside of its known inner-circle for a period of 7 days. During that time, you will be able to visit our dreamlike beaches, take some well-deserved R&R under our sunny weather, or simply just take a walk or go for a swim.

Additionally, all travelers shall be

- Required to produce a negative RT-PCR test of less than 72h, including children over 11 years old
- *Required to test again on the 7th day*
